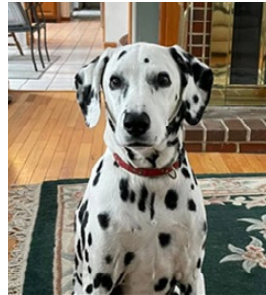
### EMBER'S PAWS OF HOPE



**EMBER'S PAWS OF HOPE:** A nonprofit organization dedicated to providing emotional and mental support to veterans and first responders through the use of future certified therapy dog(s). Members of our team have a diverse background which include being trained in critical incident stress management and peer support, and we visit fire

stations, police stations, hospitals, and veterans facilities to offer comfort and companionship to those who serve our communities.

**THE ANGEL:** Ember was 9 weeks old when she moved in with Tim Nickels, the goal was to have Ember become a therapy dog. It was discovered that Ember was too attached to Tim but no one knew that would save him later on. Anytime Tim was having a hard day or a bad shift Ember would sit with Tim. Tim was diagnosed with PTSD in 2020, Ember wouldn't leave his side. Ember knew something was up. Tim became suicidal and made attempts to end his life. Ember stopped him at least three times. When the days were dark, Ember wouldn't let him leave without her.



**THE PROJECT:** National American Legion asks Departments to partner with local organizations to support BE THE ONE. Commander McKenzie has chosen to partner with Ember's Paws of Hope (EPOH), an organization committed to provide, comfort, support, and emotional healing to veterans and first responders through the unconditional love and companionship of therapy dog. EPOH is dedicated to enhancing the wellbeing of those who serve our communities and country, offering a source of solace in times of stress, trauma and hardship.

**THE PLAN:** We are asking all American Legion Posts and/or members to financially contribute to Ember's Paws of Hope. This new 501-c-3 needs funding to provide more trained therapy dogs and make more appearances to provide physical, emotional and social well-being to others in need.

Transmittals not received by the cutoff date may not prevent a subsequent renewal notice from being delivered at or around the renewal date. Please note, renewals transmitted and received by the cutoff (which is also a National Target Date) will be updated prior to printing renewal notices, assuming they can be successfully scanned. Membership that must be hand-keyed (new members and renewals that can't be scanned) will take longer to process. Please transmit as early and as often as possible in advance of the Target Dates to help avoid delays in processing.

Target dates fall on the second Wednesday of the month unless there is a holiday on that day or at the beginning of that week. The October Target Date is moved a week to allow departments to participate in Fall Meetings without affecting membership processing for that week. Since Veterans Day falls on a Monday, the November target date will be on a Thursday.

# Standard Operating Procedures From The Post Adjutant's Guide & MyLegion.org Instructions

## Post Adjutants Guide: ONLINE MEMBERSHIP PROCESSING

To process membership and transmittals, post and squadron adjutants and commanders must be signed in to [MyLegion.org](https://mainelegion.org) and access My Groups.

The following is a brief overview of how to process membership and transmittals:

### Renew members

- Click "Process Membership" in the lefthand menu.
- Click "Add/Modify Transmittal" to open the post transmittal window.
- Search the member's name and check the box to the left of the name to renew. If no results are found, the member is already paid or is in a pending batch. Results in this search provide only the names of members eligible for renewal. The member is added to the transmittal batch and summary recalculates. Click "Save."
- Repeat this process for each member to renew. Select "Save" with each member added.
- Review the post transmittal summary, which will also update the amount due. If the dues are not correct in the summary, contact department headquarters.

### Add a new member

- Click "Process Membership" in the lefthand menu.
- Click "Add/Modify Transmittal" to open the post transmittal window.
- Click "Add/Transfer Member" to view add/transfer scenario. A member information window will appear where you can add as much information as possible and save. Saving will add the member to the batch.

### Transfer a member

- Click "Process Membership" in the lefthand menu.
- Click "Add/Modify Transmittal" to open the post transmittal window.
- Click "Add/Transfer Member."
- Enter Member ID number and last name (required). Then click "Continue."
- Verify member information, make any updates and save. Finalize the transmittal
- The "Save" button allows the transmittal to be saved and finalized on a later date. Transmittals are to be finalized within 14 days from the date opened.
- Selecting "Finalize" displays the members in the batch for a final review. Click "Finalize" a second time to reach the payment information window. To view members in the transmittal batch at any time, click "List Selected."
- Add payment information or select "Saved Bank Account" and "Pay Now." Check the "Authorization" checkboxes, then click "Pay Now." A transmittal receipt will appear for you to print or save.
- Bank information can be updated when finalizing a batch. On the transmittal payment window, select "Update Account Information."

## Transmittal review

Review transmittal history from Group profile. Go to "Transmittal History" on the lefthand menu. A table will display a summary of transmittals. Select the transmittal number to view members in the batch.

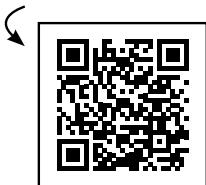
