

# The American Legion Email Advisory

#### **Email Impersonation Attacks**

Whether you are NHQ staff or a volunteer of the American Legion be aware that threat actors are always looking for ways to compromise your work or personal email accounts. The American Legion is purposefully an open organization both in its public relations and veterans' assistance programs. All post, department, and national positions who communicate electronically are at risk of being targeted. Sometimes those attacks come from already compromised email accounts. The message you receive may look very real at first look.

\*\*BEFORE you take action on a request, be certain the email you received was authored by the apparent the sender. If the message looks somewhat wrong, feels not quite right, or asks for something out of character, verify it with the sender.

#### What We Have Seen:

### I need a few gift cards or some form of electronic money:

Threat actors or scammers, will attempt to push the recipient to buy gift cards and send the account numbers for the cards over email or SMS (texting). Often the scammer will ask you to send them a text so they can move to a different communication channel. We have also had scammers text first and then move to email.

### Please log in to see this very important document:

This ruse is used most often to dupe the recipient into logging into a fake site. This may be an email host site (Gmail, Hotmail, etc.) or Office 365 depending on what the threat actor knows about the recipient. Once you have logged into this fake site you find there is a junk document. The bad guy now has your account credentials and will be harvesting your messages and contacts and sending out further scams from your mailbox.


If you are in doubt of a message's validity when the sending address is a known value, try contacting the requestor outside of the email address they use to send. A phone conversation can be the best method to uncover attacks that are in play.

At NHQ we have implemented security measures that alert us immediately when a staff account has been compromised. We have also added multi-factor authentication that prevents a threat actor from logging in even if they have "learned" a user's password.

We recommend that you set up multifactor authentication for your personal email, financial, and other online accounts containing personal data.

#### **6 Tips for Taking Better Cell Phone Pictures**

#### 1. Position

Photography is all about perspective and sometimes that perspective is best when the landscape position is used. Don't be afraid to tilt your screen to see which position will be best for your photo. The landscape position sometimes provides a better aspect ratio for the photo you are trying to produce. The landscape position is also an excellent choice for shooting video with your phone.

#### 2. Don't Use Zoom

Don't zoom in if you want to keep your photo quality high!

#### 3. Use Natural Lighting

Aim for soft, natural lighting when you're taking photos. Outside, shade or an overcast sky is the best conditions for great pictures. Inside, take pictures near a window or open door, with any artificial light eliminated (artificial bulbs turned off). Use flash only when it's necessary, as it creates harsh lighting

#### 4. Hold Your Phone Steady

One area where cell phone cameras are usually lacking is in motion stabilization. Therefore, it's important to hold your phone steady whenever you're taking a photo. Consider investing in a mini cell phone tripod stand if you're serious about cell phone photography.

#### 5. Clean the Lens

Get in the practice of cleaning the lens before taking any important photos. The last thing you want is a dirty lens getting in the way of a perfectly good shot.

### 6. Change the Focus

Make sure that your focal point is set to the subject of your shot. The focal point doesn't just change the focus. It also has a bearing on the lighting adjustments that your camera makes. If you want to experiment a little bit further with photography, play around with the focal point to focus or blur various parts of your subject matter.




spy delivering much information to her army intelligence dept. until she contracted malaria & had to go to a civilian hospital. She later married another Canadian & moved to Texas after the war.
