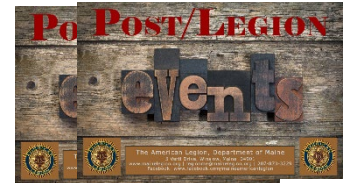
### **What: 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Chapter 14 Memorial Ride**

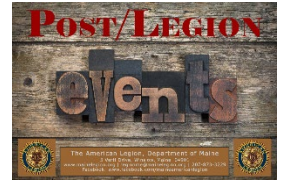

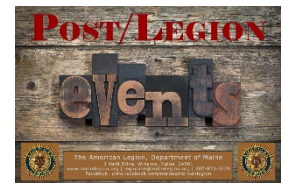
